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


Curriculum Support-

Your child will have lots of support in their lessons to help them achieve their target grade.

Wellbeing



Your child's wellbeing is just as important as the academic grades. We have lots in place to support your child.

Your child has access to-

- ✓ **Year Team Leaders** (Heads of year)
- ✓ **Faculty Data Leads**, to track your child's progress.
- ✓ **Heads of Faculty**, to help with subject related questions.
- ✓ **Special Educational Needs Department (SEND)**
- ✓ **An Attendance Officer**, to support parents and pupils to achieve good attendance.
- ✓ **Careers advisor**, to help your child know about colleges and different careers.
- ✓ A guide to help pupils with **anxiety**
- ✓ **Welfare Officer** for pupils who are struggling and need someone to talk to
- ✓ **School Counsellor** for ongoing problems
- ✓ **Pupil Centred Profiles** to help support some pupils (basically a 1:1 to help get to know pupils)
- ✓ **Behaviour Team**, to help with any behaviour concerns
- ✓ **Personal Development Program** (form time) to help pupils self-manage in the wider world
- ✓ **Barriers**, staff will get a list of barriers that your child has to help them in **class**.

Financial support which may be offered to your child

- Revision Guides free of charge in year 10 for year 10 and 11.
- School meals provided for up to £2.60 daily
- Revision packs with highlighters and flash cards in many subjects.
- 40 x £100 subject scholarships available for pupils who want to pursue a passion or interest.
- Free access to library books
- Rewards days for excellent behavior and attendance.



Other opportunities available on application-

- Contribution to music lessons.
- Contribution to school trips
- Contribution to PE kit and Uniform in some select cases.
- Contribution to food lessons.
- Application to loan a school laptop.
