



Tudor Monarchs- date of reign, picture and biography.				
Henry VII 1485-1509		Henry VII was the first monarch, after winning the Battle of Bosworth Field. He married Elizabeth of York to end the War. He made England rich during his reign.		
Henry VIII 1509- 1547		Henry VIII was famous for having six wives (including having two of them executed) and brining England away from the Catholic chrich. He formed the Church of England		
Edward VI 1547-1553		Edward VI came to the throne at only 9 years old. Thereforem the country was run by his protectors. He was only 15 when he died and he made the England even more Protestant than his Dad.		
Mary I 1553-1558	LEVE	Mary I was Henry's eldest daughter. She aggressively tried to make England a Catholic Country again, She burned those who were against her earning herself the nickname, 'Bloody Mary;.		
Elizabeth I 1558-1603		Elizabeth turned the country back to protestant again but wanted to create more of a fair balance between both religions. She had a long and successful reign, often known as the Golden Age. She defeated the Spanish Armada a in 1588.
