Dear Parent/Carer

As you may be aware, Cooking and Nutrition is now a compulsory part of the school curriculum up to the age of 14. We have looked to ensure that the dishes are appropriate to the needs of our students here at Kingsbury as well as following the Government Guidelines set out in The School Food Plan. We appreciate that a busy family life makes it difficult to shop and organise these ingredients on a regular

basis and therefore are seeking to ease this burden by asking that you return the following slip and pay £10 via School Gateway.

Students will of course be able to take the food product home as usual and will be required to bring the appropriate <u>named storage</u> for this purpose.

- If students have false nails or nail varnish on their nails, they will be asked to remove this. If they are unable to remove it, they will not be able to cook, due to health and safety and hygiene.
- Students behaving in an inappropriate manner during lesson times which makes practical work unsafe will be stopped from cooking regardless of payment.
- Students **MUST** follow behaviour expectations and normal health and safety rules (discussed in lesson)
