Dear Parent or Carer,

As we welcome our students back to school, I write to inform you of some changes, updates and improvements that we have made for the new school year. I would also like to take this opportunity to formally welcome our new Year 7 parents/carers to our school community.

Over the summer, extensive building improvement works have been taking place, and continue to take place over the coming weeks. Despite the disruption this will cause, we know that the resulting toilet refurbishments will be worth it. Due to unforeseen events that have taken place during the summer works, I have contacted Year 9 and 10 parents/carers to delay the start of students in these Year groups until Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> September. This means that student start dates will be as follows:

Year 7	Tuesday 5 <sup>th</sup> September 2023
Year 8 and Year 11	Wednesday 6 <sup>th</sup> September 2023
Year 9 and Year 10	Thursday 7 <sup>th</sup> September 2023

This staggered start will allow us to effectively inform students of the changes and additional arrangements, as well as ensure that the temporary arrangements can work effectively as we gradually increase numbers. I appreciate that this is not ideal and I am grateful to Year 9 and 10 parents/carers for accommodating this change at short notice.

#### **Building and Resources Improvements**

As indicated above, significant work has been taking place to improve the learning environment at Kingsbury. These improvements include:

- Refurbishment of both toilet blocks (English block toilets are due to open next week and the main block toilets will open later this half term) – temporary toilet facilities have been installed while this work is taking place
- New flooring to the main block stairs and landings
- Refurbishment of our reception area
- Additional signage and wayfinding in the school buildings
- Installation of digital screens and Apple technology in ten classrooms
- Installation of a new Wi-Fi infrastructure
- Reconfiguration of our Phoenix Suite (Inclusion and Pastoral Support area)

All of the above will significantly improve the environment and learning provision for our students. We hope to host an open morning and evening for parents/carers to come and see the improvements, sometime in October.
